Humanitarian community continues to struggle with climate change in 2010: An interview with Mr. Bekele Geleta, Secretary General of the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC)

The failure of the Copenhagen Climate Conference to reach a global legally binding agreement on greenhouse gas reductions indicates that this year may prove to be an uncertain one for climate change.

Negotiations are in an impasse, but the devastating consequences of global warming are gathering pace.

Now in its 150st year, the world's biggest humanitarian organisation, the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC), is at the forefront of this struggle. It is faced with battling the devastating effects of climate change on human populations, and with trying to prevent its escalation. All the while advocating the plight of the world's most vulnerable to the world's most powerful.

Mr. Bekele Geleta, Secretary General of the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC), met us to discuss what the future holds.

How will climate change impact on the developing world, especially the Middle East?

The impact of climate change can be seen everywhere. It is already hitting the poorest of the poor and it is hitting them the hardest, they are the first line of suffering. In regions like the Middle East we are seeing growing water scarcity and a knock-on effect on crop production.

Is there a lack of awareness among politicians?

We cannot say that Governments are not aware - 110 heads of state gathered at Copenhagen. The world considers climate change a serious issue and it is committing its political will and resources to finding a solution.

On the ground, however, there is a need to educate every part of society including policymakers. There is still a big gap between what the science tells us and what some people believe. It is the role of politicians to close this gap. This is true in the Middle East, in Africa in the developing countries and yes, also in developed countries. What is really encouraging though, is the overall awareness of the younger generations the world over.

What role do the IFRC and its national societies have when it comes to fighting climate change?

The IFRC has a world-class climate change centre in the Netherlands. Its mission is to advocate for climate adaptation and disaster risk reduction, and integrate knowledge of climate risks into our strategies and activities.

We are also working towards 'early action.' This does not mean helping someone run to a top of a hill when they see flood waters rushing in. It means helping people change their way of life

gradually. We inform people how to manage their resources in a sustainable manner.

This has to be a bottom up movement so we have volunteers who live in communities and lead by example. This allows people to emulate their behaviour and adopt it as their own. This approach has changed a lot of lives, including in Syria where we have a very strong base and the capacity to mobilise volunteers very quickly.

What can we expect from the IFRC in the future fight against global warming?

We have a global responsibility to protect, support, and empower people. This means representing their interests at global negotiations, like Copenhagen, but it also means raising funds to help us deal with global warming. New funds are necessary to address this global threat to human security. If funds are moved away from areas of need, such as food security, we are only exacerbating the problem.

As an organisation we are acting to reduce our carbon foot print and change our behaviour. Our international strategy for the next decade is to figure out how to use our resources most effectively and incorporate climate change into our wider humanitarian and developmental role.

Syria is suffering from the devastating effects of the drought in the north-east. How are the IFRC and its Syrian Arab Red Crescent branch helping to alleviate the situation?

Syria is one of the 25 countries in which we are implementing experimental climate change programmes developed by our climate centre. We are involved in activities from health to water management. We are also trying to mobilise the international community, but so far the drought appeal has only achieved 30 per cent of the estimated requirement.

Migration is a big problem. It's a consequence of natural disasters, but in regions where poverty is widespread migration has a devastating effect on people's livelihoods.

We are sure that the number of people affected by disasters will continue to grow over the coming years. I think this is one of the main concerns of conferences like the COP15. Whatever the result, work has to continue and official action has to be taken. (Jesús Marco Gamero.
